



Admissions Policy

The Pre-School is registered for 36 children aged 2-5 years and it is our intention to make our Pre-school genuinely accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community.

1. We accept children at the start of the term after they become two years old, Looked after children (in care of Local Authority) will be given priority for admission places.
2. If and when a waiting list is needed, it will be arranged in order of date of birth, from the date of application, and then in proximity to the Preschool. Consideration may also be given to families who have played an active part voluntarily in the running of Pre-School.
3. We welcome both Fathers and Mothers, other religions and other carers, including child minders, and people from all cultural, ethnic, and religious and social groups, with and without disabilities.
4. We describe how our practices treat each child and their family, having regard to their needs arising from their gender, special educational needs, disabilities, social background, religion and ethnicity or from English being a newly acquired additional language.
5. We make our Valuing Diversity and Promoting Equality Policy widely known.
6. We consult with families about the opening times of the setting to ensure we accommodate a broad range of families' needs.
7. We are flexible about attendance patterns to accommodate the needs of individual children and families, providing these do not disrupt the pattern of continuity in the setting that provides stability for all the children.
