



Aims of Pre-school and Organisation Policy

Aims of Moulton Pre-school.

1. To provide high quality, affordable and accessible childcare to children aged from 2 to 5 years.
2. To work in partnership with parents and Carers to ensure equal opportunities are offered for all children and families
3. To give children the opportunity to socialise with other children and adults in a safe, supportive and stimulating environment.

Organisation of Moulton Preschool

Moulton Preschool is a registered charity and is run by an elected Committee which ensures the major decisions are in the hands of the parents who use the group. A Annual General meeting is held yearly in the Autumn term. The Committee employ qualified staff member who are in charge of the day to day running of the group and deliver the education and care of the children daily.

A high adult: child ratio is essential in providing good quality Preschool care. We have a 1:8 ratio for children aged 3 – 5 years, and a 1:4 ratio, for children under the age of 3 years.

All staff attend regular meetings to undertake curriculum planning and discuss the Children's progress.

The Preschool budget has an allocation for training costs and training is available through Cheshire West and Chester, Preschool Learning Alliance (PLA) and Total People.

Moulton Preschool is registered to accept 2 year old funded places as well as 3 & 4 year old funding.

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
